


Consumers

- Licensed Installers
 - Design and install septic systems
 - Permit from Environmentalist
- Licensed Pumpers
 - Clean and inspect septic systems

Onsite Wastewater Workers

- Licensed Manufacturers
 - Cast and provide approved septic tanks
- Licensee Roster aowb.alabama.gov




Installation or Repair Costs

 - Local Health Department


Do's & Don'ts - Septic Tank

- Do
 - Regular pump/inspect
 - Address problems
 - Landmark/access
- Don't
 - Garbage disposal
 - Non-biodegradables
 - Additives/enzymes



Do's & Don'ts - Disposal Field

- Do
 - Conserve/meter water
 - Effluent filter
 - Divert water
- Don't
 - Harmful/Hazardous
 - Parking/Compaction/Construction/Planting
 - Pools



Septic System Problems

- Signs
 - wet spots in the yard
 - slow draining toilets or drains
 - gurgling sounds in your drains
 - sewage odors
- Actions
 - Environmentalist
 - Licensed Professional

Low-Income Households

- AOWA TRAC Program
 - Income-dependent
 - Septic system work at no cost to homeowner
 - AOWA members donate equipment and labor
 - Limited number of systems
